Los Angeles Team Mentoring (LATM)
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Groups Served by Program

LATM serves middle school students within the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD). Student mentees represent the diversity of the Los Angeles community, including African-American, Middle Eastern, Asian and Latino students, many of whom are refugees or immigrants.

Program Description

Teams of adult mentors work with groups of youth using an activity-based curriculum focused on leadership development, team building, community service, conflict resolution, and cultural diversity. Mentor teams are made up of teachers, college students, and community volunteers. Los Angeles Team Mentoring programs operate as after-school programs in 14 different LAUSD school sites.
